- Each state party has committee in CA, 3,200 voting members
- Those 3,200 are drawn from county committees, assembly districts voted in odd years in January
- 80 assembly districts, each send 14 delegates
- Next step is the club; have the power to endorse
- Who can this club contact to be in touch with State Party?
  - Regional Directors are responsible for county clubs, constituencies, ours is Royce Kelly
- State Party has its own annual convention. This year in Sacramento in May.
  - Democratic State Central Committee are those who vote
  - 3 buckets of people:
  - Over time, registration declining (both major parties)
  - New voters do not register in party
